Once you have created your Naviki-Account on [www.naviki.org](http://www.naviki.org) and are logged in, simply click on the “UPLOAD” Button on the top of the page. Here, you may either add a GPS file or draw your route.

### Connecting Paths: Create Europe’s Largest Cycle-Path Network

In a few months, Naviki will offer Europe-wide cycle routing. This service is already available in Germany, and will shortly be started in Denmark, Italy, Spain and The Netherlands. It will offer genuine routing and, what’s more, connect all uploaded tracks to one large cyclable network – covering the whole of Europe.
